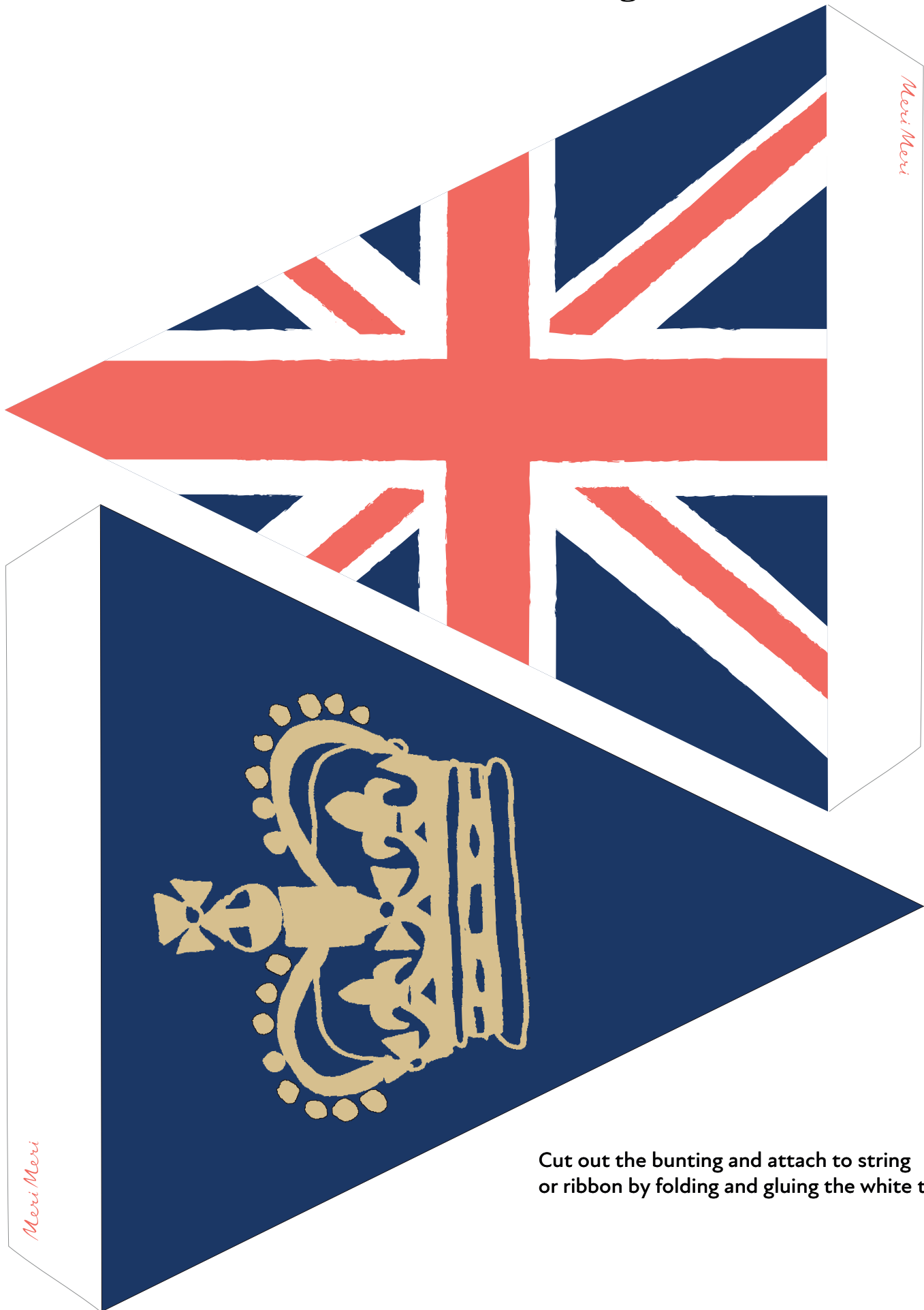
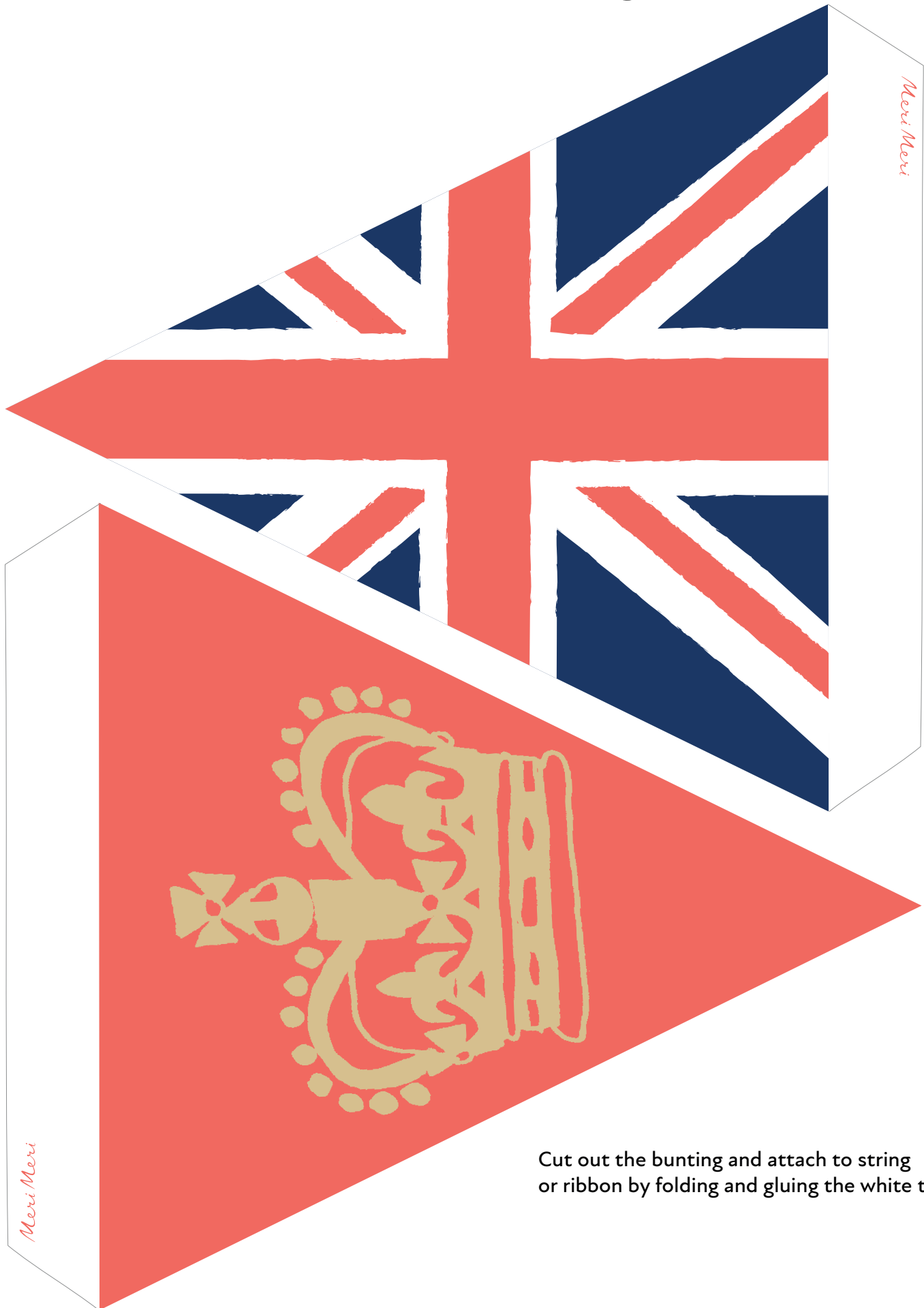


Coronation Bunting



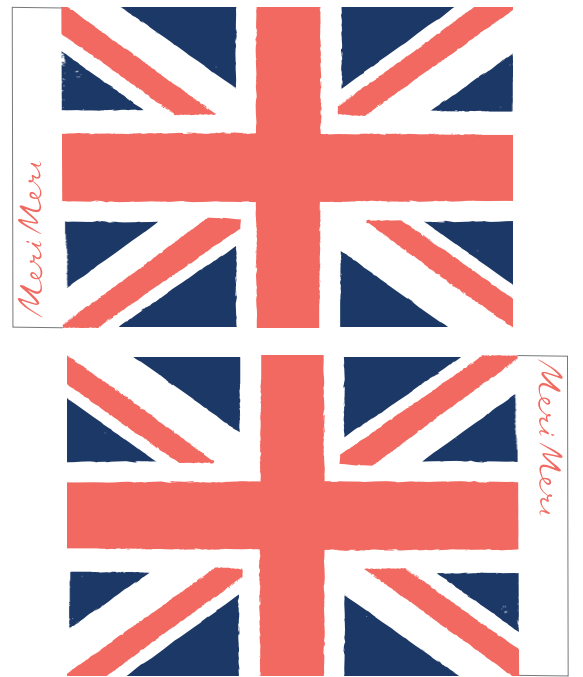
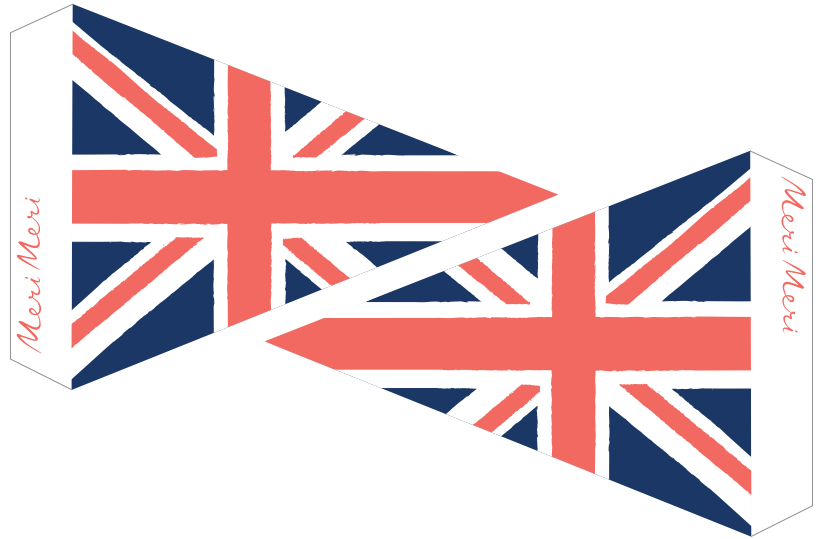
Coronation Bunting



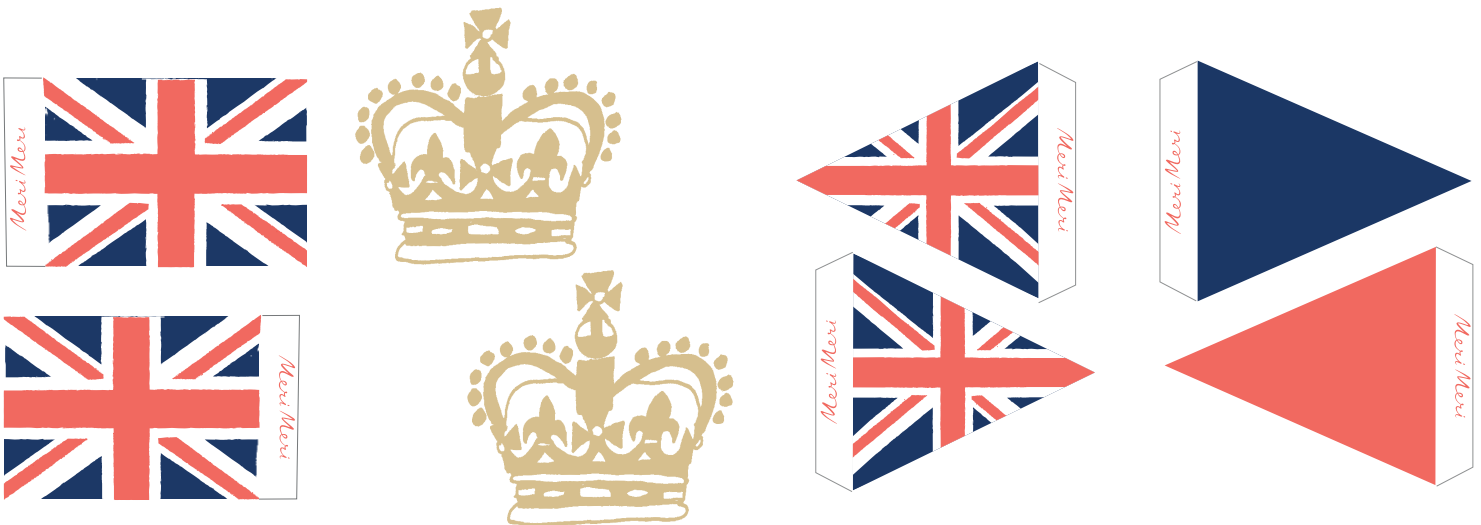
Cut out the bunting and attach to string or ribbon by folding and gluing the white tab.

Cut out the flag, including the white tab. Glue the back of the white tab and fold or roll around a stick.


